Trained Hospice Social Workers, Hospice Bereavement Volunteers and YMCA staff will guide children & youth through their grief responses and facilitate effective coping skills. A separate adult support session will be offered on the last day, Sunday.

*Grief is experienced by children in unique ways. Regardless of whether the loved one was a relative, a friend, or neighbor; OR if the death was expected, unexpected, or traumatic - this opportunity is for all!!*
