A Journey Shared by a Hospice Family.

When loved ones are living out their last days at home, it can be an especially difficult and emotional time. We thank the Laboy family for allowing their personal journey to be shared showing how through supportive loving care, we provide patients and their family's comfort for body, mind and spirit.

When Angel Laboy was diagnosed with lung cancer, he relied on his deep spirituality to keep fear at bay. After multiple visits to the hospital, it was determined and discussed with Angel and primary caregiver, his daughter Jatleen to consider Hospice for his next plan of care. And so, began their journey with Hospice of Orange and Sullivan.

Having the interdisciplinary care team (physician, nurse, LPN, hospice aide, social worker, chaplain, and volunteer) we provided not only care for Angel but also a support system for Jatleen and her five children, with who he lived with.

Each week, his care team provided the care and support needed through every aspect of care. His deep connection to his chaplain, Laura M. kept Angel emersed in his spiritual life through his bible and prayer, keeping him fearless to continue experiencing quality and joy of life, his family and especially his grandchildren.

Angel lived with five of his grandchildren and had twenty in total and always made sure there were treats in the house like ice cream, donuts or cookies when they visited him. Although he lived with his only daughter Jatleen, he was grateful to spend much time with his sons, Joel, Angel and Christopher when he could. The love and closeness of his family, including the mother of his children, Rosa, who lives in Puerto Rico, were his greatest blessings.

Jatleen believes it was through the amazing care her father received from his nurses, Kristine H. RN, Heather G. RN, Heather F. LPN ("The Heathers") Dennis R. LPN, and especially his hospice aide specialist, Suzanne H. that allowed her father the best quality of life he could have.

Hospice care includes all hospice-related medications and equipment needed to ensure this. The hospital bed, pain management medications, walker, commode and oxygen that was provided to Angel made the difference in his daily life.

Social Worker Sara C. and Hospice Volunteer Maria D. offered emotional support for Angel and especially for Jatleen.

Having their volunteer Maria speak Spanish was very comforting for them all. Hospice care knows the emotional and physical demands of being a caregiver, and through this level of support, it makes an important difference in the lives of those who support and care for the patient. Through the Friends of Elizabeth Fund, designated for special patient needs, Sara was able to secure funds to assist after a storm knocked out their power including making sure Angel had his favorite food, Cheddar Cheese.

The support both Sara and Maria D. offered to Jatleen was needed and very appreciated. Being a single mom with five children and primary caregiver is understandably difficult and why the importance of family care is paramount.

Angel was admitted to the Kaplan Family Hospice Residence in his last days. When the time came for Angel to close his eyes, Jatleen was comforted in knowing that his strong faith made it a peaceful ending. As Jatleen said "It was

a gift for us all to have Hospice a part of our family in the caring of my father. There was no way we as a family could have provided the care both Dad and at times I needed. I am at peace knowing he is my guardian angel now."

***Angel Laboy received Hospice Care earlier than most. Due to his illness and continued need for end-of-life care, he qualified to receive this care for close to 3 years. Unfortunately, most do not inquire about hospice care until very late in the prognosis, preventing all the benefits of hospice services to be used.**

The sooner you call, the more support and services we can provide to both patient and family.






Holiday Tree of Life






