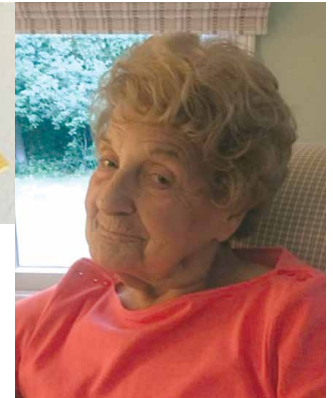

Last year I was honored by my employer Citizens Bank with the Chairman Award, the highest recognition for the work I do for my clients. The award offered the opportunity to donate \$2,500 to the charity of my choice. That was an easy choice, the donation would go to Hospice of Orange and Sullivan Counties for the support and care my family received during a difficult time in our lives.

My mom, Robin Dyson-Velez, needed assistance with helping care for my Nanna, Carolyn Evelyn Bosch when she was diagnosed with liver cancer and dementia. Hospice of Orange and Sullivan was contacted and provided hospice care at home in Eldred, where she lived with my mother. As the weeks went on, my mother was able to care for Nanna with the help of the hospice care team.

After some time, Nanna became increasingly agitated making it difficult for my Mother to continue caring for her at home. The thought that she might have to go to a nursing facility was Mom's biggest fear, as the family cared for Nanna at home for many years. Upon speaking to her hospice care team, the Kaplan Family Hospice Residence was offered as a possible option. Mom prayed that night and prayers were answered the next morning when she was told a bed was available.

I had experience with hospice home care at home but did not know what to expect at the Kaplan Family Hospice Residence. When I first arrived, I saw it was a beautiful place. It felt like a retreat with a therapeutic and calming environment, but what my family and I experienced went far beyond what we could have imagined. The nurses and medical staff had a wonderful bedside manner, and the volunteers were warm and compassionate. They were attentive to my Grandmother and provided the comfort and care she needed most while preparing us as a family for what was to come as we took this journey together.

Hospice of Orange and Sullivan not only provided care for my Grandmother, but also provided at home care for my grandfather, Robert I. Bosch and stepfather, George Velez. All three experiences exceeded our family's expectations.

I am honored the award gave me the opportunity to have a gold leaf In Memory of Carolyn Evelyn Bosch placed on the Tree of Life at the Kaplan Family Hospice Residence. The quote inscribed on the leaf is a statement she used often.

*"Never say goodbye, always say **"auf wiedersehen"**. Until we meet again."*

# Join us for our 14th Annual Golf Classic



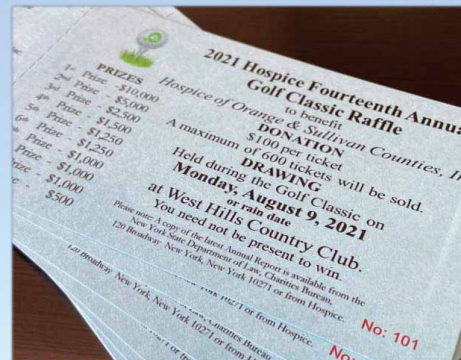

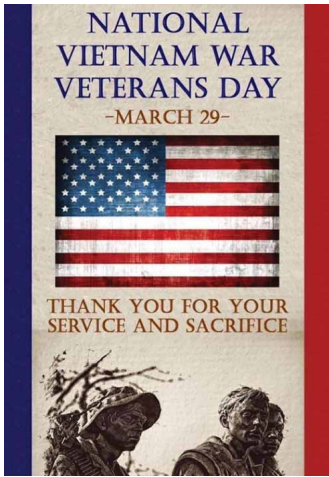

# Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans Day

***The Vietnam War Veterans Recognition Act of 2017 was signed into law designating every March 29 as National Vietnam War Veterans Day.***

On a brisk and windy March 29, 2021, **HOSPICE of Orange and Sullivan Counties** with the support of **Newburgh VFW Post 973, Orange County Veterans Service Agency and Vet2Vet MHA** held a Vietnam War Veterans Recognition Ceremony at the Orange County Veterans Memorial in Newburgh. It was an honorable recognition that included the laying of a wreath, the reading of the 68

Orange County Vietnam Veterans names engraved on the memorial monument, and the playing of Taps (National Song of Remembrance) by Dave McTamane, VFW Post 973. Christian Farrell, Director of Orange County Veterans Service Agency spoke of the meaning of the day and Larry Neuman, from Vet2Vet, did the honor of placing the beautiful red, white, and blue wreath at the base of the monument.

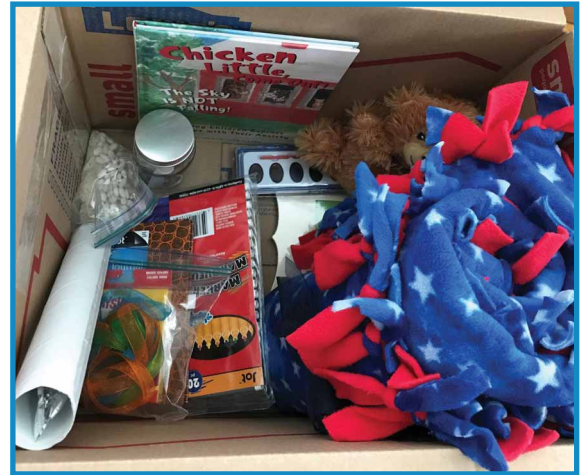
